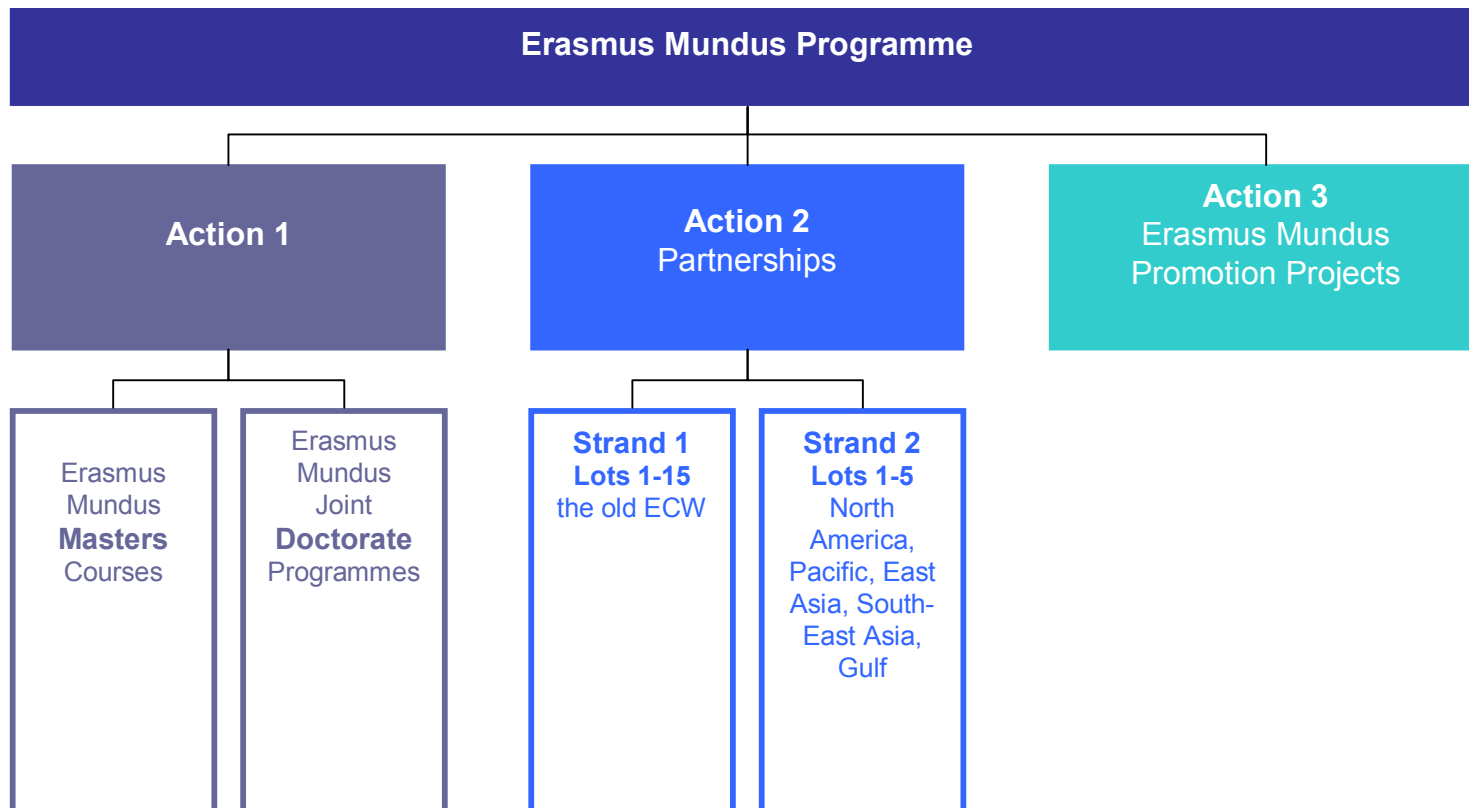

- 1st Call for Applications on 24 October 2011
 - Long mobilities (degree studies) and exchange studies (non-degree)
 - Mobilities start in autumn 2012
- 2nd Call for Applications October 2012
 - Exchange studies only
 - Mobilities start in autumn 2013

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANTS

- All required documents must be submitted by the deadline
- Formal EMA2 criteria are respected (Coordinator)
- TG1 Home Universities confirms status of their outgoing applicants
- Applicant meets host's academic and formal criteria (Host University)



GRANT NOMINATIONS

- Based on academic criteria
 - Academic performance of the applicant
 - Study motivation
 - Study/research/work plan
 - Language skills
- Transparent application and selection process



GRANT DISTRIBUTION

- Minimum quotas: Belarus 30; Moldova 30; Ukraine 40 of total 203 grants
- No pre-selections by sending universities
- Saturation point in TG1
- Geographical distribution
